All arenas/classes are outside on grass. Trailer parking is available in a pasture area close to arena. Fast food restaurants available within 2.5 miles. In case of heavy rain or other weather issues, please look at www.kdea.org the morning of the show for any cancellation or delay information.

Class Information

Combined Tests (Dressage and Stadium). Fee: \$30.00 per class. Horses must be at least 4 years old
Derby Class (Dressage, Stadium/XC course) Fee: \$35.00 per class. Horses must be at least 4

All combined test dressage tests (except for Starter division), must be ridden from memory! Note that Beg/Nov, Novice, and Training eventing dressage tests are NEW FOR 2018 and are dated "effective 12/1/17. They can be found at: <http://useventing.com/competitions/dressage>. - **Class 1. CT Starter Division. Dressage: 2018 USDF Intro Test C (small arena). Stadium: Cross rails or verticals, not to exceed 18"
- Class 2. Derby Starter Division. Dressage: 2018 USDF Intro Test C (small arena). Stadium: Cross rails or verticals, not to exceed 18" and small Cross Country logs.
- **Class 3. CT Beginner Novice Division. Dressage: 2018 Beginner Novice Test A (small arena). Stadium Only: 8-10 jumping efforts over a course of up to 500 meters at 300 meters per minute. Maximum height 2'7"
- Class 4. Derby Beginner Novice Division. Dressage: 2018 Beginner Novice Test A (small arena). Stadium and XC: 8-10 jumping efforts over a course of up to 500 meters at 300 meters per minute. Maximum height 2'7"
- **Class 5. CT Novice Division. Dressage: 2018 Novice Test A (small arena). Stadium Only: 8-12 jumping efforts over a course of approximately 350 meters at 320 meters per minute. Max height 2'11.
- Class 6. Derby Novice Division. Dressage: 2018 Novice Test A (small arena). Stadium and XC: 8-12 jumping efforts over a course of approximately 500 meters at 320 meters per minute. Max height 2'11.
- Class 7. CT Training Division. Dressage: 2018 Training Test A (small arena). Stadium Only: 10-12 jumping efforts over a course approximately 400 meters at 325 meters per minute. Maximum height 3'3".
- Class 8. Derby Training Division. Dressage: 2018 Training Test A (small arena). Stadium and XC: 10-12 jumping efforts over a course approximately 700 meters at 325 meters per minute. Maximum height 3'3".

Jumper Classes = Class Fee -\$20.00 Each

Class 9 -Crossbar (18")	Class 11 – 2' 3"	Class 13 -- 2' 9"
Class 10 – 2' 0	Class 12 - 2' 6"	Class 14 -- 3 Foot

Anyone can enter Class 15 but Required Class for those registered for the Flying Diamond Challenge Cup:

Class #15(J) – July Show - Gambler's Choice Harmony– Jumps are all assigned "points" and riders have 60 seconds to accumulate as many points as possible, still crossing the finish line before 60 seconds. Highest number of points wins (-4 points for any rails down), as long as you cross the finish line within 60 seconds. Required (no cost) for Challenge Cup horses and \$20.00 for all others.

Class #15(A) – August Show – Alphabet Soup Harmony – Jumps are labeled with letters, and you draw a word and you have 5 minutes from your "draw" to spell the word via taking jumps in the correct order without audience assistance. Correct spelling and time to determine winner. Required (no cost) for Challenge Cup Horses and \$20.00 for all others.

Hardhat and boots required at all times when mounted! Even spectators & spouses or friends! Please note: Dogs required to be on leashes, children under 15 must be accompanied at all times by an adult, and emergency contact information is required on the entry form
